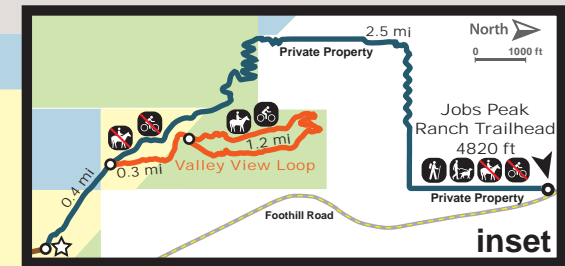


Fay-Luther/Jobs Peak Ranch Trail System

Dogs Allowed

Must be on leash November 15–March 30 to protect the winter deer population and year-round on easement through private land
