2020 Bently Heritage Trail Overview

1) All three loops and five river spurs were brushed out a few times. Growth is nearly continuous and excessive with limited use.

2020 Clear Creek Trail System Overview

1) Thirteen fallen trees were removed from the trail.

2) A 50-foot section of trail was realigned to improve biker safety below Knob Point.

3) A 75-foot section of trail was realigned to improve biker safety below Five Valleys View.

4) A 25-foot section of trail was realigned to broaden a turn that was causing excessive trail skidding and rutting above Five Valleys View.

5) A 100-foot section of trail was realigned to improve biker safety above Cliff Rock.

6) A 25-foot section of trail was realigned below Cliff Rock to improve a switchback approach for bikers. The switchback was also widened and re-armored.

7) A 150-foot realignment was completed to improve a climbing turn above Cliff Rock.

- 8) A 90-foot realignment was built on the Clear Creek Connector to improve sight line.
- 9) The Upper Jacks Valley Trailhead kiosk lexan panel was cleaned to remove linseed oil stain streaks, tape, dust and dirt.

- 10) Two separate brushing and drainage maintenance walk-throughs were completed on the entire Clear Creek Trail and Clear Creek Connector.
- 11) Multiple fence cuttings around trailheads were restrung.

2021 Clear Creek Trail System Work Plan

- \checkmark Routine brushing, benching and tread work will occur on the entire trail.
- ✓ Continue collaboration with partners to finish the Clear Creek Connector Trailhead at Highway 50 and Golf Club Drive.
- ✓ Continue efforts to complete the lower third of the Clear Creek Trail, Jacks Valley Loop and James Lee Loops.

2020 Fay-Luther/Jobs Peak Ranch Trail System Overview

1) Seven fallen trees were removed from the trail system.

2) One ginormous fallen bitterbrush was removed from the Sandy Trail.



- 3) Signage updates included removing faded freestanding trail maps at the Jobs Peak Ranch Trailhead and Fay-Luther Trailhead, updating the Fay-Luther Trailhead kiosk map, and adding rattlesnake caution signs at both trailheads.
- 4) Working with the Jobs Peak Ranch Homeowners Association, a new bridge was approved and installed along with an improved trail realignment. This provides a more enjoyable trail location and an easier/safer crossing of the creek drainage.

5) Four waterbars were installed and brush removed on the first 100 feet of trail at the Jobs Peak Ranch Trailhead to prevent trail rutting.

6) Two riparian areas were cleared of brush on the Fay-Luther/Jobs Peak Ranch Trail.

7) The entire 9-mile trail system had fall brushing, rock clearing and drainage maintenance performed twice.

2021 Fay-Luther/Jobs Peak Ranch Trail System Work Plan

- ✓ Routine brushing and drainage work will occur throughout the trail system.
- Continue efforts to realign a large portion of the Fay Luther/Jobs Peak Ranch Trail to a more enjoyable and sustainable trail location.
- Continue efforts to build the Appaloosa Trail and perform realignments that will greatly minimize future trail maintenance.

2020 Genoa Trail System Overview

1) Rubble was cleaned out from behind the retaining walls in lower Genoa Canyon.

2) Nine fallen trees were removed from the trail system.

3) New signs were posted on the Muller Lane access gate.

- 4) The entire trail system had general trail maintenance performed twice that included clearing rocks, brushing, drainage and trail widening.
- 5) The Eagle Ridge Trailhead had the parking lot cleaned up of needles and glass, and the road cleared of encroaching brush.

- 6) The Eagle Ridge kiosk lexan panel was cleaned to remove linseed oil stain streaks, tape, dust and dirt.
- 7) Genoa Trail System maps were updated to the latest edition at the Muller Lane kiosk, Genoa Lane kiosk and the Whit Hall entrance at River Fork Ranch.

8) A rubble rock wall was completed on a turn in lower Genoa Canyon.

9) Brushing was completed in lower Genoa Canyon along Genoa Creek.

10) A switchback on the Sierra Canyon Trail had a rock rubble wall built.

11) Brushing was completed in two drainages above Eagle Ridge Trailhead.

13) Six trail areas were widened in lower Genoa Canyon.

14) A scratched sign post was replaced and a graffitied sign was painted over on the upper Sierra Canyon Trail.

15) Graffiti was removed from the Eagle Ridge Trailhead kiosk.

16) Additional graffiti was removed from the Eagle Ridge Trailhead kiosk.

17) Several dumped leaf and needle yard waste piles were removed from the Eagle Ridge Trailhead.

18) Boulders at the Eagle Ridge Trailhead were pushed downhill with heavy machinery. These were brought back up and replaced using rock bars and a backhoe.

19) Two boardwalks were installed on the East Brockliss Loop over intermittent wet areas.

20) A 70-foot section of trail was realigned to reduce grade on the Genoa Loop.
